### Certificate of Pedigree

#### Guidelines and Rules

If your horse is not able to meet the requirements allowing it to be fully registered you may be able to obtain what is called a "Certificate of Pedigree". Following are the rules for such a certificate which shows the bloodlines of the horse. Please contact the OHBS office for further information.

#### § 19 Certificates of Pedigree

- 19.1 A white certificate of pedigree is to be issued when conditions for the issuing of registration papers are not fulfilled. The following requirements must be met:
- a) in the year the mare covered, or at the latest in the year of the birth of the foal, the sire was entered in the stallion book of the Verband, or was provisionally licensed by the Verband or the mare was entered in one section of the Verband's studbook but she was bred to a non-approved stallion.
  - b) the identification of the foal at the mare's foot is assured by a Verband's authorized person or is confirmed by genetic parentage verification.
- 19.2 The certificate of pedigree shall contain the same information as the registration papers.
