Origin: Dacaprio's sire, Grand Prix stallion Davignon I, is one of the most highly profiled and sought after Donnerhall sons.

Donnerhall is well known as the Dressage Horse of the Century. Damsire, Caprimond

was Reserve Champion of the Stallion Licensing in Neumunster in 1987, the following year he won his Stallion Performance Test at Adelheidsdorf with an outstanding overall score of 135.35 (1/56), placing first in dressage with an exceptional score of 147.76. Due to his highly successful offspring he was named 1998 Trakehner Stallion of the Year. Caprimond was shown up to Grand Prix and still competes at that level with his young rider, Theresa Wahler, who began showing him when she was twelve.

Performance Record: Dacaprio was the third most expensive stallion at the Stallion Licensing in Verden, Germany in 1998 when he was purchased by Hengststation Jens Meyer. Dacaprio passed his Stallion Performance Test at Adelheidsdorf the following year as a three-year-old with the Class I Dressage Index of 122.00 points. At the ages of three and four Dacaprio won several under saddle and Materiale Championships. As a three-year-old, he won the German Hanoverian Riding Horse Championships over all three and four year-olds in Verden with the exceptional overall score of 8.9, receiving one score of 8.5 for his canter and four scores of 9 for walk, trot, rideability and conformation. Also in 2001, Dacaprio was successful at the International Sire Horse Show in Zwolle, Netherlands. As a six-year-old he continued his list of success with victories and placements in dressage performance tests up to M Level as the winner of M/A-dressage tests (Intermediate level).

Breeding/Progeny Record: Breeding/Progeny Record: Dacaprio is well known for producing great impulsion, high elasticity, enormous rideability and is especially noted for producing modern type in his offspring. Dacaprio's well-known offspring include Bundeschampionat winner and World Breeding Championship Bronze Medalist FBW Dejau, Bundeschampionat competitors/qualifiers Del Mondo and Daylight (dressage), Didi le grand (eventing) and Braveheart (show jumping). Like his sire Dacaprio, Del Mondo won the German Hanoverian Riding Horse Championships. In 2006, Dacaprio was the sire of the gold medal foal at six foal shows in Baden-Wuerttemberg. Because his offspring were highly esteemed and he himself was successful in M/A-level dressage tests, Dacaprio was awarded a Main Premium from the South German Warmblood Federation. Dacaprio has sired three licensed sons including the 2008 Licensing Champion in Zweibrücken, over 20 States Premium mares and many successful Verden auction horses as well as internationally successful competitors throughout Europe. Successful imported offspring competing in the U.S. and Canada include EM Dallara (2nd highest scoring MPT on 2006 AHS tour), EM Dakota, EM Dacapria, SPA/EMC Daylight, SPS Dacorina, Da Lana, Dahlia The Black, Des Chappelles, Dimaggio, Dhenmark, Valient, Bond Street, Dactylo, Donner Geist, and Dollar 99. He has the high breeding value of 140 and belongs to the top 100 dressage sires of the German National Equestrian Federation (FN).
