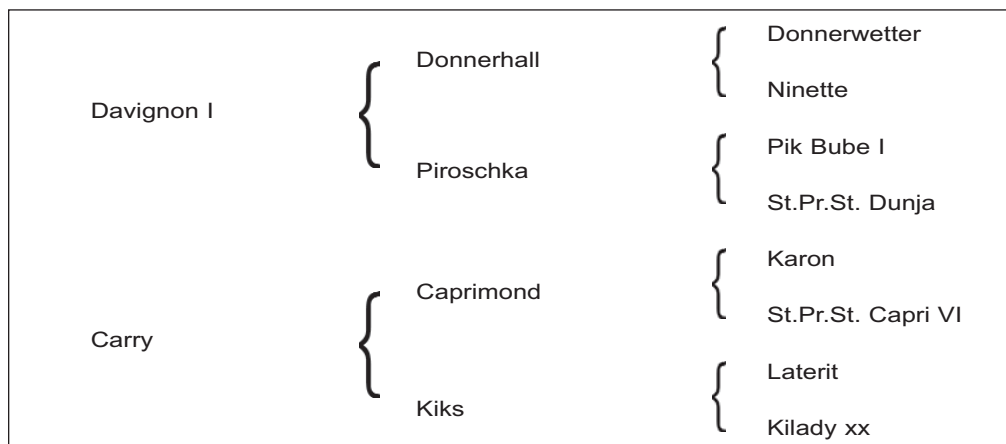

Origin: Dacaprio's sire, Grand Prix stallion Davignon I, is one of the most highly profiled and sought after Donnerhall sons. Legendary Oldenburg stallion Donnerhall is well known as the Dressage Horse of the Century. Davignon I, was winner of the Federal Championships of Young Horses (Bundeschampionate) and competed successfully up to Grand Prix level. He has produced over 30 licensed sons, 64 State Premium mares as well as successful dressage horses competing through the Grand Prix level. Dacaprio's dam, successful dressage competitor, Carry, is the full sister to Chippy, dam of Elite Hanoverian stallion De Laurentis. Carry also produced Dacaprio's full sister, State Premium Decala. Damsire, Caprimond was Reserve Champion of the Stallion Licensing in Neumunster in 1987, the following year he won his Stallion Performance Test at Adelheidsdorf with an outstanding overall score of 135.35 (1/56), placing first in dressage with an exceptional score of 147.76. Due to his highly successful offspring he was named 1998 Trakehner Stallion of the Year. Caprimond was shown up to Grand Prix and still competes at that level with his young rider, Theresa Wahler, who began showing him when she was twelve.

Performance Record: Dacaprio was the third most expensive stallion at the Stallion Licensing in Verden, Germany in 1998 when he was purchased by Hengststation Jens Meyer. Dacaprio passed his Stallion Performance Test at Adelheidsdorf the following year as a three-year-old with the Class I Dressage Index of 122.00 points. At the ages of three and four Dacaprio won many under saddle and Materiale Championships. As a three-year-old, he won the German Hanoverian Riding Horse Championships over all three and four year-olds in Verden with the exceptional overall score of 8.9, receiving one score of 8.5 for his canter and four scores of 9 for walk, trot, rideability and conformation. Also in 2001, Dacaprio was successful at the International Sire Horse Show in Zwolle, Netherlands. As a six-year-old he continued his list of success with victories and placements in dressage performance tests up to M Level as the winner of M/A-dressage tests (Intermediate level).

Breeding/Progeny Record: The Hannoveraner Jahrbuch Hengst placed Dacaprio in the top 15 for all sires (based on his mare rankings) and he belongs to the top 100 Dressage Sires of Germany (FN). Dacaprio produces great impulsion, high elasticity, enormous rideability and is especially noted for producing modern type. His offspring are highly successful in Europe and the U.S. Dicello was the 2008 Rheinland-Pfalzar Stallion Licensing winner as a 2-1/2 year old, and winner of the South German Riding Championships. At 6 years of age, Debbie was dressage Bronze Medalist at the 2009 German-Junior-Championship with her 16 year old rider. Seven year old, Donatella is currently winning in Germany at S level (PSG) in dressage. Dacaprio also had a son in the 2009 Verden Stallion Licensing. These join the well known offspring Bundeschampionate winner and World Breeding Championship Bronze Medalist FBW Dejavu, B-Championate competitors/qualifiers Braveheart (show jumping), Didi le Grand (eventing), Del Mondo and Daylight (dressage). He has sired 5 licensed sons, 2 were licensing champions, over 25 States Premium mares and many Verden elite auction horses. His first U.S. foal crop has exceeded expectations, many winning at breed shows and awarded Premium at their inspections. At 5 months, Dalton HHF won the 2009 GAIG/USDF Breeders' Championship Series New England Series Final Grand Champion Colt. Mature imported U.S. competitors include EM Dallara (2nd highest scoring MPT on 2006 AHS tour), EM Dakota, EM Dacapria, SPA/EMC Daylight, SPS Dacorina, DiMaggio, Dhenmark, Dalton, Valient, Bond Street, and Dollar 99.
