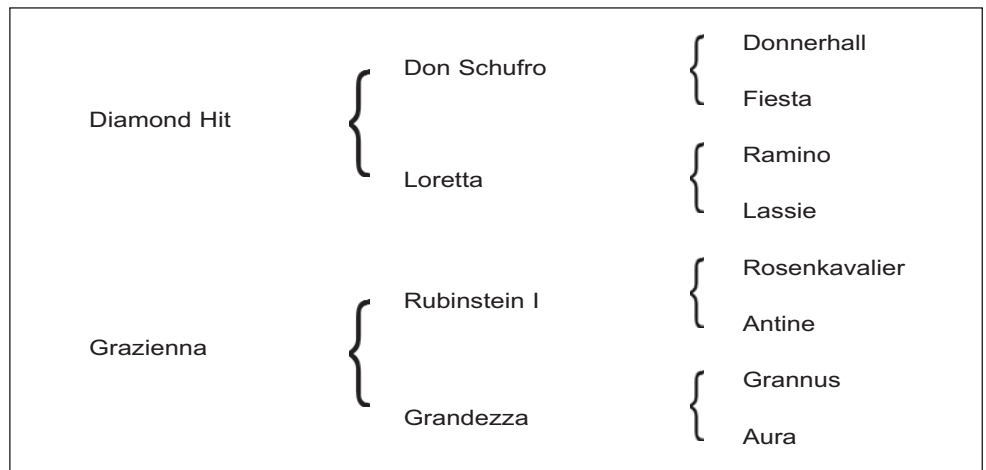

Origin: Sire Diamond Hit successfully absolved his 30 day test in Vechta in 2000 and went on to become the 2001 Res. Bundeschampion 4yr old Stallions. Grazienna's sire, the famous Rubenstein I, was from the outset one of the most popular sires who ever stood in Oldenburg. After an outstanding stallion performance test, in which he was placed third and an excellent first crop, he was the overwhelming main premium winner in 1990.



Performance Record: In 2004, Donates was the Training level Horse of the Year with a median average of 75.8% as well as the Cosequin Colt Champion. In 2005, he won the Sporthorse Mature Stallions, Stallion Champion with scores to 81.8% at the Silver Hills Breeders Show! Other accomplishments in 05 include - 2005 American Bankers 1st level - Open Champion; 2005 USDF DSHB Champion Stallion 81.4% and 2005 USDF/Cosequin Southern Series Breeders Championship, Stallion Champion. He continued his winning ways with the Reserve Championship of the 2005 Rheinland 30 day testing with an overall score of 8.31. He received the highest score given for rideability, a 9. He also had the highest Interior score, 8.63 and the highest canter score, 8.75! To cap off the year, he was named the Oldenburg Horse of the Year at Second level and USDF Stallion Horse of the Year. At Devon in 2006, Donates was 2nd in the DSHB 4-year-old & older stallions and 2nd in the Stallion Championship class. He was 5th overall in the FEI 5-year-old dressage test with a score of 7.4%. Donates won Reserve Champion in the 2007 - 6 year old USEF/Markel National Young Horse Championships with a 7.804%! He has been competing at 4th Level and PSG in Florida in 2008 with consistent scores in the high 60's. He has recently fulfilled all requirements to earn his lifetime stallion approval status through performance. He is an outstanding young stallion with the gaits, temperament, and conformation to both produce and perform with tremendous success. His most outstanding quality is his trainability and rideability which he passes on to his offspring. Donates is approved by Gemany's Oldenburg Verband as well as by Zweibrucker, Rheinland Pfalz-Saar.

Breeding/Progeny Record: Donates is an exciting opportunity for North American Dressage breeders! He brings the sought after bloodlines of Diamond Hit, who is sired by the Blue Hors Star Don Schufro combined with the famous and legendary sire, Rubinstein I. Classic European breeding combine in a fabulous package to offer an unparalleled opportunity to bring some of the best that Europe has to offer to breeder s here in the United States! He has 3 foal crops who have been predominantly rated Premium status. His foal made their first appearances in the show ring in 2006. His filly "Dior" was Champion Filly of 2006 Dressage at Devon with a score of 80.2%. She was later 2008 Region 9 USDF DSHB Reserve Champion Filly and Winner of "Born in the USA" 2008 Dressage at Devon 2 year old fillies. His son Don Petroff was the 2008 Region 9 USDF DSHB Champion Colt, 2008 Reserve Champion DSHB HOY Yearling Colt, and 2008 Champion Oldenburg DSHB Yearling Colt with a 76.3%. Donates' other offspring, Desert Rose, Dream Weaver and Designing Grace are also racking up points in the show ring. Dream Weaver was 4th 2008 USDF DSHB HOY with a 78.5% and 2008 DSHB Reserve Champion Oldenburg 2 year filly. Desert Rose was 2008 DSHB Champion Oldenburg yearling filly with a 75.3%. These offspring were presented at the 2008 Dressage at Devon where Donates was 4th in "Get of Sire". His first foal crop are now starting under saddle and will be making their appearance in the show ring in 2009. Donates consistently produces foals that are of excellent temperament and quality for amateur or the professional rider.
