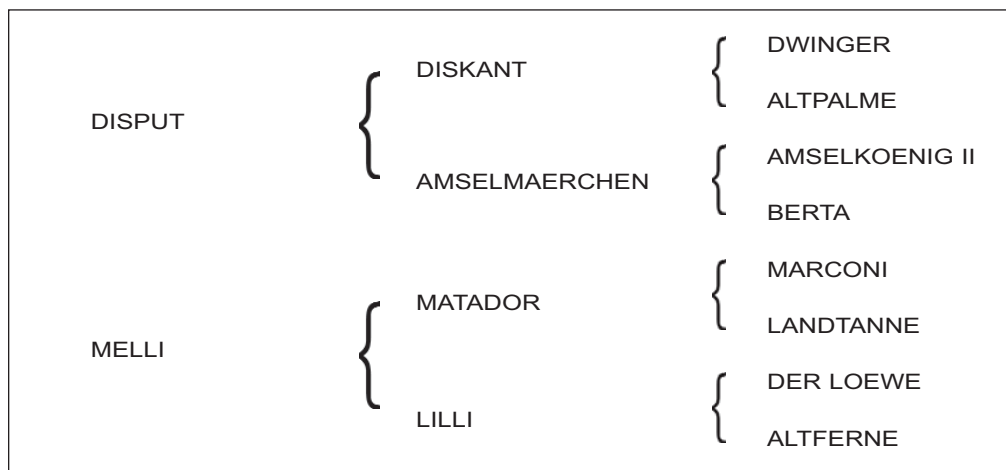

Performance Record: The exceedingly handsome black Donnerwetter was trained to Grand Prix by the great riding master Herbert Rehbein. He was sold to Belgium where he competed for several years and resurfaced again at Uli Kasselmans in Germany, then finally returned "home" to Gronwohldhof where he again stood at stud for a limited time. Purchased by Winsome Farm, Donnerwetter moved to a lovely farm in the US where he remained secure and cared for like the champion he was until his passing. He competed with success as a Grand Prix stallion in the winter Florida circuit. He was an extraordinary horse even in his elderly years.

Breeding/Progeny Record: Donnerwetter was used primarily as a stallion in sport and unfortunately for the breeding world he was not made available for breeding a good number of years. He produced 33 mares in Germany that were used for breeding of which 5 were awarded State Premium and 6 approved breeding stallions. He is most noted for his outstanding world class Oldenburg son DONNERHALL who also represented Germany in the World Equestrian Games. Other successful stallions are Donnerhall's full brother Disco Dernier, Donnerkiel, Donnerklang, Dobrock, and Diamant. Donnerwetter's progeny were not only good producers of breeding stock but they were also very high quality riding horses, many reaching the Grand Prix level.
