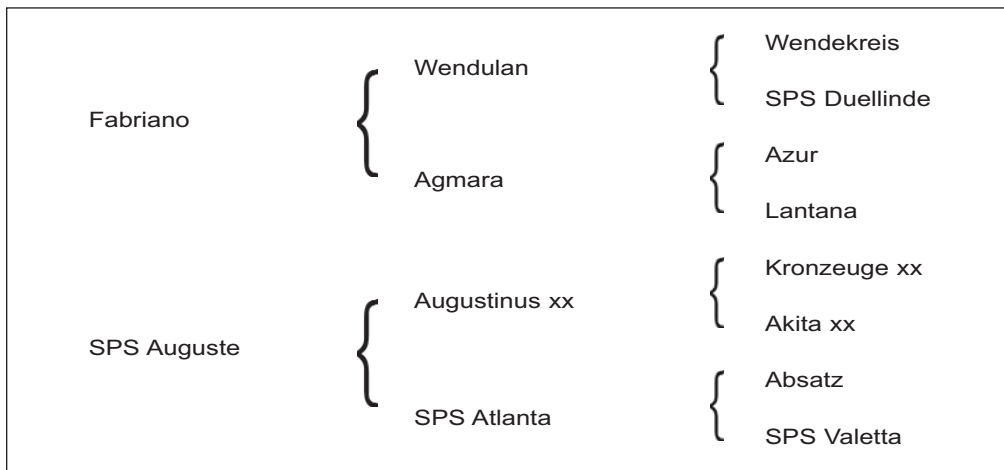

Origin: Fabuleux's sire, Fabriano was Champion of his 100-Day Test (133.02), placing 4th in dressage (128.55) and 1st in jumping (132.37). According to the Hannoveraner Jahrbuch Hengst, Fabriano scored 136 on his mares dressage qualities, 125 on their jumping abilities and 157 on their foundation (leg scores/correctness) making him one of the very few stallions on the Hanoverian Verband's Toplist for siring both outstanding dressage and jumping qualities. Dr. Wilkens, former managing director of the VhW, calls Fabriano "one of the best performance horse producers of Hanover's breeding program today". Fabriano passes on to his progeny elasticity, exceptional gaits, jumping ability and rideability, together with a very good character. Fabuleux's dam, SPS Auguste, is by Augustinus xx, an important refining sire and top producer of modern type jumping and dressage horses. SPS Auguste is the full sister to licensed stallion, Aquamarin, and was an immensely successful broodmare and producer of four state premium mares and two licensed stallions. She represents six generations of SPS mares. Her offspring have in turn produced States Premium mares and successful German Sport Horses. Fabuleux offers proven performance genetics to American breeders through the carefully selected combination of one of Germany's most successful mare families and his exceptional sire, Fabriano.

Under saddle, Fabuleux's offspring are exceeding expectations as they begin their under saddle show careers and are noted for their outstanding trainability and rideability.
