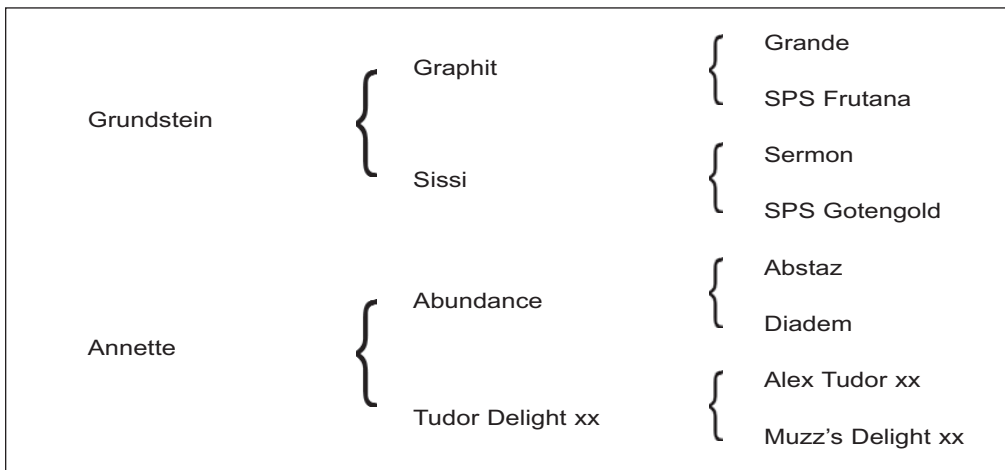

Breeding/Progeny Record: Gold Luck has been consistently producing top foals and premium foals at inspections. He now is producing mares which have top foals, proving his worth as a broodmare sire. He has produced multiple winners and Grand Champions at breed shows across the nation. He has produced top ranked USDF year end award winners competing through fourth level and Ghotcha is now reaching FEI levels in competition. All the following horses were bred by Rolling Stone Farm: Ghambade, a Gold Luck gelding was 4th at the 2006 USDF/ Markel Young Horse National Championship in the FEI 6 year old test, ridden and trained solely by his owner. EMC Ghlycerine was multiple times Breed Show Grand Champion in 2006 and was second at Dressage at Devon for the USDF Sporthorse Breeders Championship, receiving the Born in the USA award for the second year in a row. Ghypsy, Gholfer, Ghlacier, Ghalewind and Ghenoa were winners in the breed show ring. EMC Ggamma Ray was the co-recipient of the 2005 AHS Benchmark Award for the highest free jumping score in the Mare Performance Test, and earned the fourth-highest Mare Performance Test score of that year. Ghuatamala was the high score Hanoverian mare at the large 2006 PA inspection with a score of 7.61. Ghenoa was the 2006 Mid Atlantic Hanoverian Breeders Club Grand Champion, was winner of her inspection with a 7.55, and then winner of her MPT in 2007. At fourth level in 2008, Ghlenlivet is 12th nationally for the USDF, first for AHS All Breeds and he won the region 2 finals. Gaudenzia is first for the USDF All Breeds Awards for 2008 at training level with a 78.4% and is first for the AHS. Gold Luck has produced 6 Elite Mares and 3 Elite mare candidates.
