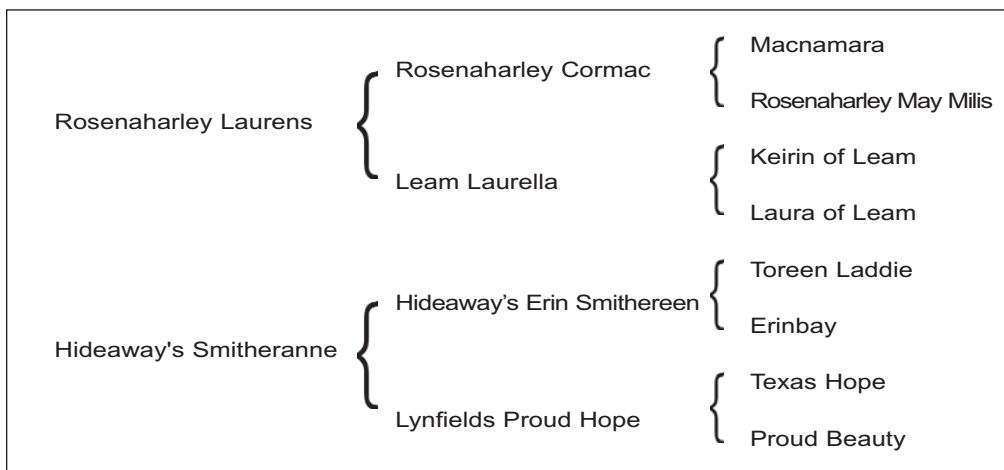

**Origin:** Harry's sire was the imported stallion Rosenaharley Laurens from the Rosenaharley Stud in England. His sire's line goes back to Macnamara, who is thought to be one of the greatest Connemara Stallions ever to stand in England. His Dam,

Hideaways Smitheranne, was bred by Hideaway Farm and goes back to Toreen Laddie and Proud Beauty. Smitheranne was a half sister to the winningest stallion in the history of the USCTA, Hideaway's Erin Go Bragh.



**Performance Record:** Greystone's Adirondack A'Herne (aka Harry) has been shown exclusively as a pleasure driving pony over the past 5 years. During that time he has won approximately 50 Champion and Reserve Champion driving titles, plus numerous Year End High Point Awards. In his first year of competition he accumulated enough points to be the New York State Horse Council High Poing Driving Pony. He then went on to win the Pony Championship that was held at the New York State Fair. The following year he returned to the New York State Fair and won the Open Pony Driving Championship. The past three years Harry has won the Driving Championship at the Region I (New England) Connemara Breed Show. Over the past two years more concentration has been put to developing Harry as a Combined Driving Pony. He has participated in several two-phase events where he has had much success. His Driven Dressage scores have been as high as 75.71% at the Preliminary level. The Summer of 2007 he competed in his first Intermediate test and won with a score of 65.41%

**Breeding/Progeny Record:** Harry is a quality performance stallion with looks, outstanding movement and an unbeatable disposition that he passes on to his get. In 2006, prior to being approved by the Weser-Ems, three of his daughters were presented at Oldenburg Inspections in NY and CT. All three were approved and entered into the Main Mare Book of the Weser-Ems Ponies. Two of those mares have started their careers in the Hunter Ring and the third produced an outstanding filly by Hilken's Black Delight.
