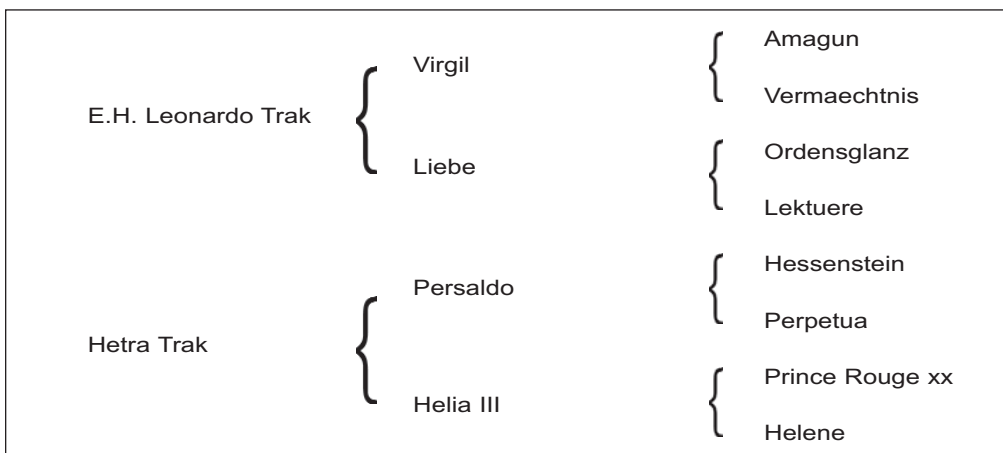

Origin: Herzberg, a most highly noble and elegant true-to-type Grand Prix Dressage Trakehner Stallion, has the infusion of Trak. Lightness and "blood" clearly sought after in the modern sporthorse. With some of the most successful and proven bloodlines, such as E.H Leonardo, a very worthy riding horse sire with extremely good active gaits. A sire whose progeny excelled at FEI Levels in Dressage and Jumping in Germany. Virgil, who was Champion at his Keuring and Champion at his 100 day test in Medingen, Germany. Together with Herzberg's Dam, Hetra, an elegant and Typey Trakehner mare with strong sporthorse features, comes such Legendary sires as Persaldo, Hessenstein and Ordensglanz.

Performance Record: After his Keuring, Herzberg went on to successfully pass his 100 day stallion testing at Adelheidsdorf, Germany. Herzberg then went on to Claim the Title Landeschampion of the 4 year olds in Jumping in South Germany with a score of 9.0! After that Herzberg was able to claim many ribbons in Material and young horse dressage and jumping classes in Germany. After his arrival to the United States, Herzberg has been very successful in Dressage Classes up to International CDI-W*** Level. In 2003, Herzberg has won numerous Prix St. George and Inter. I classe's with scores up to the 73.750% and Grand Prix classes to 71% and took home multiple Championship Titles in national and large International CDI***competitions. Herzberg was named 2003 ATA Prix St.George Horse of the Year, and 2003 Reserve Champion ATA Intermediaire I Horse of the Year. Herzberg also won the 2004 USDF HOY Intermediaire I ATA Award. At Rancho Murrieta CDI-W*** Herzberg was able to place 5th in the Grand Prix and 3rd in the Grand Prix Special also giving him his first world cup points. Herzberg ended up 14th in the USET Grand Prix Rankings in 2005.

Breeding/Progeny Record: Herzberg shows once again through his foals the Brilliance in movement with exceptional activity of the hind limbs. All of Herzberg's foals stand out in beauty, presence and temperament! In 2009, High Definition, stallion prospect sired by Herzberg competed in the USEF 4 yr old Dressage classes winning with high scores. His first US crop of offspring are now competing under saddle with amazing scores in Dressage classes. Herzberg's offspring are a great pleasure to start and have an amazing work ethic. His offspring have proven to be very rideable and have a very active hind-leg with lots of rhythm and suspension in trot and a huge ground covering uphill canter. Many of Herzberg's foals received the Premium Award or Gold Medal with multiple verbands. 2005 was very exciting for Herzberg's offspring, every one received premium and a Colt out of a Figaro x Goldstern x Luciano mare became GOV Inspection Site Champion also capturing the Premium award. Herzberg has sired many Verband Elite and State Premium Mares for the RPSI Verband in Germany, Herzberg has also sired Verband Premium Champion Mares here in the U.S. with multiple verbands.
