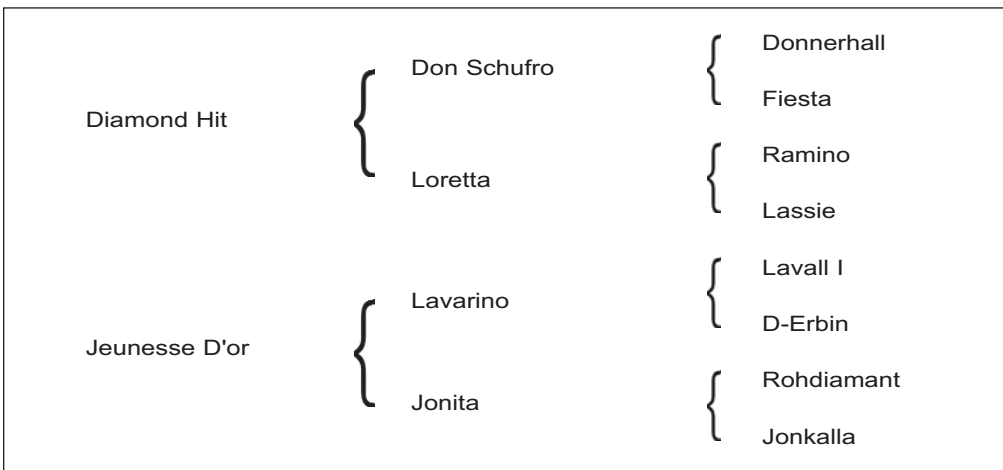

His phenomenal sire Diamond Hit is a Champion many times over, including titles earned at the World Championships for Young Horses and the Bundeschampionat. He further declared superiority over his peers when the German Ministry of Agriculture honored Diamond Hit as the Best Licensed and Performance Tested stallion of all breeds in 2001. Diamond Hit is a son of the international Grand Prix stallion Don Schufro. Don Schufro attained Olympic status under Andreas Helgstrand in addition to leading the FN Index since 2001 as the leading producer of dressage horses. Diamond Hit's dam, the Elite Oldenburg mare Loretta, is also mother to the near legendary Sandro Hit as well as the Premium stallion Royal Hit having thus created a new brotherhood in Oldenburg royalty.



Diamond Stud's damline brings further acclaim to this beautifully bred stallion. Damsire Lavarino was Champion of the 1996 Holsteiner Stallion Licensing. Lavarino's exquisite movement and athletic capability are exemplary of his sire Laval I's reliable influence.

The third generation of Diamond Stud's pedigree is crowned once again by Oldenburg royalty. His dam's damsire Rohdiamant is one of the most successful sons of the great Rubinstein I. Lisa Wilcox successfully campaigned Rohdiamant to Grand Prix, and went on to achieve Olympic status with his great son Relevant. Rohdiamant has produced numerous Grand Prix athletes. His is practically a guarantee for success; highly rideable, elastic, and elegant horses are his legacy.

Bred by 1980 Olympic Gold Medalist Elisabeth Max-Theurer, Diamond Stud was imported in utero and born at Highlife Farm in Orlando, Florida. This noble black stallion presents a striking appearance with his uphill build and all black coat, complete with four white stockings and a star. His movement is powerful, supple and athletic. Equally impressive is his gentlemanly demeanor in the barn and with people.

With a pedigree full of Grand Prix stars, Diamond Stud offers North American breeders a rich heritage of top performers and proven rideability.
