Hannoveraner Jahrbuch Hengste, Lauries Crusador xx has exceptional breeding values for dressage type and has greatly influenced the improvement of gaits and rideability. In Hanover, he has sired 15 approved stallions, 456 registered broodmares, and 144 States Premium Mares and 649 registered competition horses. Liberty's dam line contains many acclaimed sport horse producing sires. His dam sire, Gimpel is a beautiful, correct and athletic stallion from the legendary Gotthard G-line. A noted competitor in dressage and jumping, Gimpel is valued in Germany for producing versatile and highly trainable offspring. Great grandsire Don Carlos was one of the most successful sires of jumping horses after World War II. He is famous for siring two Hanoverian Stallions of the Year, Don Juan (1997) and Drosselklang II (2001). An outstanding producer, Don Carlos sired 283 studbook mares, 43 States Premium mares, 24 approved stallions and 467 international competition horses who won close to DM1,300,000 in prize money.

Performance Record: Liberty was purchased by Tina Konyot, well known FEI dressage trainer and competitor, soon after his Stallion Licensing in Verden when he was 2 1/2 years old. With Tina, Liberty performed all of his training up to Grand Prix level. Liberty was exceptionally easy to train, highly intelligent and always presented a great work ethic. Liberty's very first competition, (at 7 years of age), was at Prix St. Georges level on the competitive Florida Dressage Circuit. He won this very first PSG competition with the excellent score of over 70% in Wellington, Florida. His competition record includes many significant wins at Prix St. Georges through Grand Prix level at major shows with scores in the 70's. Tina Konyot comments, "Liberty is the easiest horse I've ever trained. He learned quicker than any other. You only have to show him something once and he has it. In one week he learned his one tempis..."

Breeding/Progeny Record: Liberty was retired due to a non-work related injury and now begins his career as a sire. Previously, due to his extensive performance career, Liberty was only available to breeders on a limited basis with frozen semen. We are very pleased for the opportunity to offer his highly motile fresh cooled semen to mares in the U.S. and Canada. Liberty brings strong dressage and jumping bloodlines combined with modern type to North American breeders. He is especially well suited for crossing with mares of Donnerhall, Rubinstein and Weltmeyer descent.
