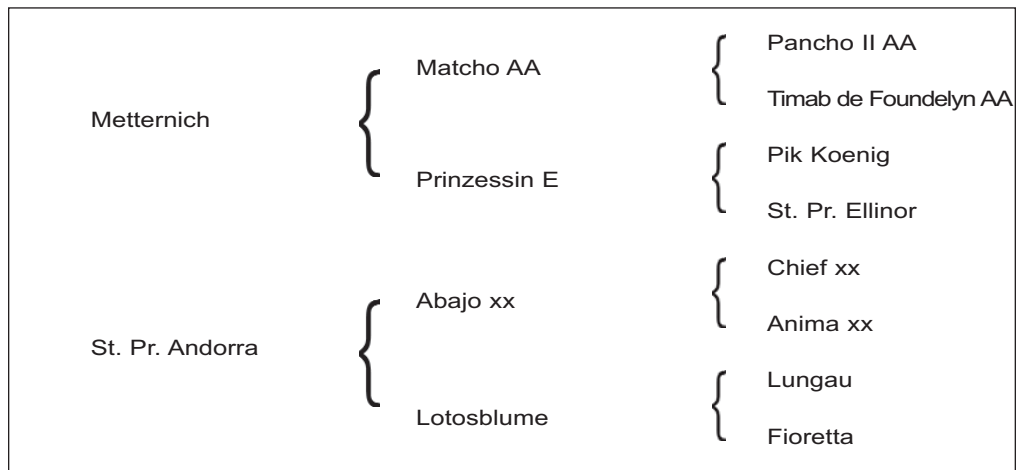

Origin: Montserrat is by Metternich, publicly known as the best son by Matcho x. Metternich is extremely versatile for both Dressage and Jumping, and prepotent to pass down the traits. Montserrat's half brother, Multistar, was the Reserve Champion at his stallion licensing in 1999, demonstrating the multi-talents in this line. Montserrat's dam-sire, Abajo, is also the dam-sire of Verden Licensing Champion William's Gold and approved stallion Pik L, now standing in the US and Pan Am Game competitor.

Performance Record: Montserrat is the Champion at his stallion licensing in Adelheidsdorf. In the same performance test group, even with 5 points deduction because he was started late, Montserrat beat his Verden Licensing Reserve Champion brother Multistar. He also scored higher than two other popular stallions that currently stand in the US, and two other stallions taken by Celle State Stud that year. Only 3 years after his licensing, he is already schooled to S level dressage by a young trainer, Joerg Dietrich. Because of his uphill movements, Montserrat's extravagant gaits are actually very easy to sit, and he has served as the schoolmaster for his amateur owner.

Breeding/Progeny Record: Montserrat's first foals just arrived this year, they are modern as expected with long correct legs and excellent movements. With his long legs, uphill modern conformation and gentle disposition, Montserrat is expected to be very suitable to cross with US breeds as well as more traditional warmbloods. Montserrat's son, Mufasa, out of a Rotspon mare was declared site champion and stallion prospect.
