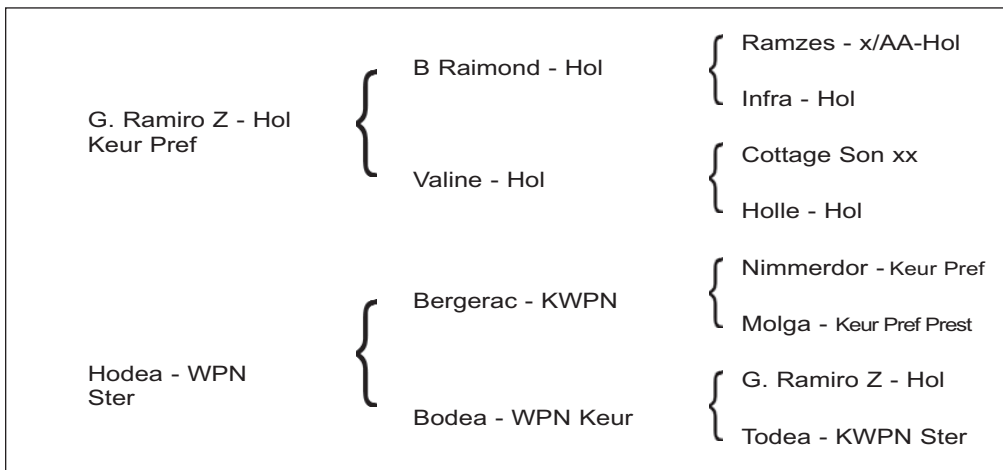

Origin: Noteworthy has exceptional European bloodlines, superb conformation & movement, and EXCELLENT character. His sire is the preferent stallion, G Ramiro Z, who was approved in every Warmblood registry in the world and had a great influence on sport horse breeding. Despite his impressive ancestry and sports results, one of G Ramiro Z's biggest claims to fame is his fertility and sperm quality. They were so excellent that he was used in the research of artificial insemination and frozen semen to produce the science we know today. This tendency for high fertility is passed on to his get, including Noteworthy. Noteworthy's dam is the Ster mare, Hodea, by Bergerac, son of the preferent stallion, Nimmerdor, who was recently named Stallion of the Century in the Netherlands and who was invited to the Olympics in Los Angeles. Nimmerdor's extreme jumping talent is passed to his offspring; he has more than 30 approved sons worldwide. Hodea's sire of dam is the preferent stallion, G Ramiro Z, making Noteworthy 62.5% G Ramiro Z genetic makeup. Although awkward to those not familiar with genetics, this feature is preferred and positive in affect.
