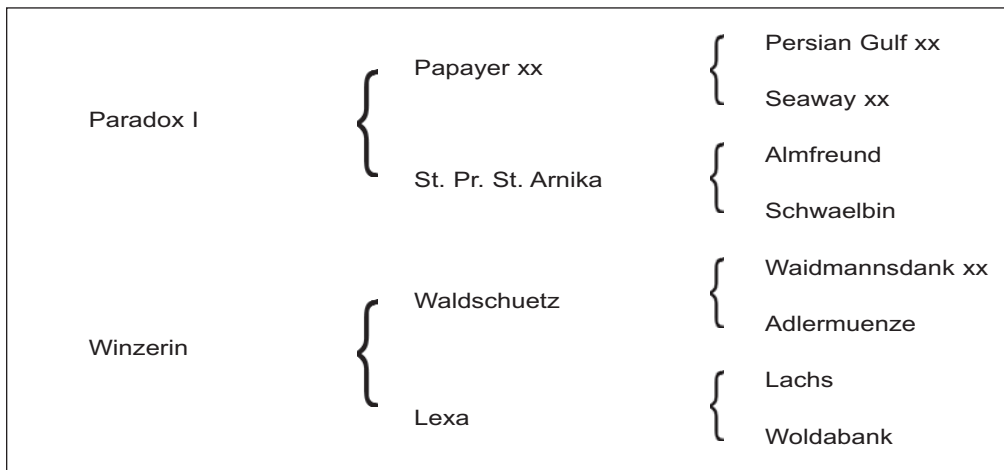

Origin: Parabol's sire Paradox is "probably one of the most important Westfalen sires of modern times," according to Hengste Deutschlands. He has sired over 300 show jumpers, 100 dressage horses, and 20 approved stallions. His dam's sire, Waldschuetz, is by the Thoroughbred improvement sire Waidmannsdank who stood at Celle and whose offspring have won 600,000DM.

Performance Record: Parabol's life accomplishments demonstrate his versatility. His early years in Germany were decorated with every honor possible for a young stallion. He won his Stallion Performance Testing with an unprecedented high score and then was title Champion of Oldenburg as a four-year-old. He was a Champion Style Jumper in the prestigious competition for young riders, Prize of the Best, jumping 5'6" courses while being judged on his quiet manner and technique over fences. Not surprisingly, Parabol is listed for the AHS Jumper Breeding Program (JPB). Upon his importation, Parabol turned to a dressage career and earned the USDF Horse of the Year Title at Third Level. He was short-listed for the 1994 Pan-American Dressage Team, long-listed by the USET for many years, and competed successfully up through Grand Prix until his retirement from competition in 1999.

Breeding/Progeny Record: Parabol's daughters have won their MPTs with very high marks in jumping. His get, including Paramont, Patagonia, and Pentium, are winning on the A Hunter Circuit at Devon, Indio, and Wellington. Parabol's offspring in Europe have achieved high States Premium licensing results and top selling auction prices (Pretty Woman sold for 520,000DM at PSI). Pharaoh, an approved Oldenburg stallion, competed through Grand Prix and Pacino, bred and owned by Hilltop Farm, is showing incredible potential as an FEI dressage horse.
