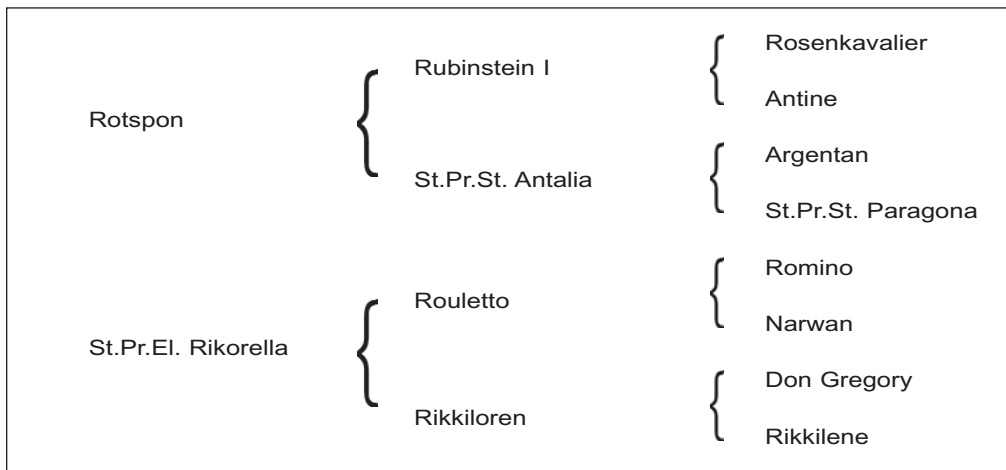

Performance Record: Rasta is completing his requirements for his permanent license with his rider/trainer Christine Rivlin-Henke, they are a competitive and decorated pair. In September of 2009, Rasta finished in the top 20 of the North American final rankings in 3rd level open Dressage Horse of the Year. Out of 256 competing horses, he ranked #15, ahead of other strong challengers and riders. He won all of his open classes during the 2009 competition year, being the high-score winner of the upper level Woodside Championships; earning a high score of 71.8 at the hardest test of the level from Anita Owen, and a high score of 72.8 from Olympic judge Linda Zang. Rasta is the Reserve Champion of the Dressage Horse of the Year for the German Oldenburg Registry (Oldenburg Horse Breeders Society) at Third Level Open in 2009. Under saddle, Rasta displays great scope, extreme athletic ability, and a brilliance for dressage and jumping of his talented and famous pedigree. Rasta won the Horse of the Year Materiale Award for the Oldenburg Horse Breeders Society NA Division of GOV, with a high score of 82.4 in 2007. Rasta was awarded the High Point Performance Horse Award and engraved cooler from the Oldenburg Verband (GOV) in 2006. He was Horse of the Year at Training Level for the Oldenburg Registry with a median of 74.8, ridden by his trainer Christine Rivlin-Henke and 3rd in the North American USDF Final Rankings; Rasta was high point award winner in 8 of his shows in 2006 including the CDI USET qualifier at Rancho Murietta, California, with an 80% from Judge Jeanne McDonald. In 2007, Rasta competed at the FEI five-year old level; qualifying for the Regionals in Flintridge, California, and the Nationals in Kentucky. Rasta competed at First Level with a median of 70+ percent. He was highlighted in the Chronicle of the Horse in February of 2006. Rasta competed as a yearling and as a two-year old stallion prospect in several in-hand, all breeds classes hosted by USDF/USEF and scored extremely high in all classes. Rasta has three stunning gaits, a powerful show ring presence, uphill balance built for the FEI upper-levels, and a rideability, trainability, and soundness of mind that is very rare. He has trained in clinics with Steffen Peters, Axel Steiner, Leslie Webb, Conrad Schumacher, Jane Weatherwax, and Roger Seegert. Rasta is a very developed, competitive stallion, making his way to the Grand Prix in dressage. And his passage he inherits from his famous Grand Sire Rubenstein I. Stunning....
