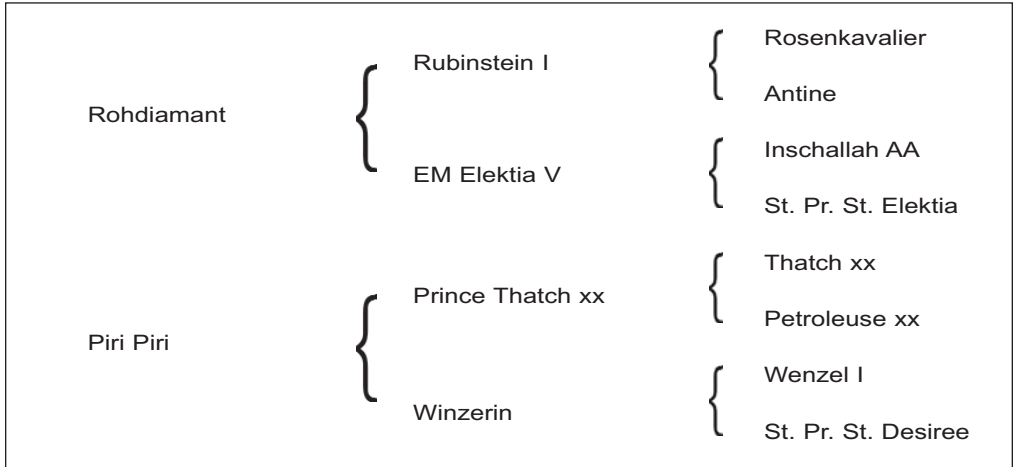

Origin: Royal Prince's sire Rohdiamant was a highly successful Grand Prix dressage competitor who was short-listed for the US Olympic Team with Lisa Wilcox. Grandsire Rubinstein also competed at the Grand Prix level and is known for the excellent rideability of his offspring. Royal Prince's dam Piri Piri is by the influential Thoroughbred stallion Prince Thatch xx. Piccolino, by Prince Thatch, helped secure the Team Gold for Germany at the 2003 European Dressage Championships and placed 6th individually.



Performance Record: Royal Prince was Reserve Champion at both his 30-day and 70-day Performance Tests. As a five-year-old, he won the East Coast Selection Trials for the World Championships for Young Horses with an unprecedented score of 9.82. Later that year, Royal Prince finished in fourth place at the World Championships for Young Horses. He was the highest-scoring Hanoverian at the championships that year, and is the highest-scoring American horse to date. Royal Prince finished the 2004 season by winning the US National Championships for Five-Year-Olds with an overall score of 9.14.

He repeated his East Coast Selection Trials win in 2005 and returned to the World Breeding Championships to represent the US. He consistently earned 9's and 10's for his walk, 8's and 9's for his trot, canter, and submissiveness over these two years.

In the fall of 2007, Royal Prince returned to the show ring and the winner's circle with Michael Bragdell. The pair have already earned Michael his USDF Bronze Medal, a Reserve Championship at the BLM Finals, and had a 2008 season average above 69% at Fourth Level.

Breeding/Progeny Record: Royal Prince's foal crops are showing their sire's elegance, refinement, and movement. He has sired a large percentage of Premium foals and Site Champions. The 2008 Filly Champion and Young Horse Champion of Dressage at Devon was sired by Royal Prince. This past year, Royal Prince's oldest offspring turned three years old and began their under saddle careers. They are proving the wonderful rideability of his bloodlines is transmitting to the next generation along with a beautiful type that is being rewarded with Elite Mare Candidate and Premium Mare titles.
