**Performance Record:** An immaculate gentleman and performer, San Rubin is a horse for the ages. Winning Champion Oldenburg Stallion as a four year old in 2004, he started showing the world what an amazing showman he is. In 2005, he was on the German Young Horse team and went fifth in the world; making a great showing for the German people. Later in that year, he won the Bundeschampionate with Dr. Ulf Mueller scoring a 9.3 overall score. He scored well into the 70s and 80s in second level and third level under Steffen Peters. This year he is third in All Breeds Horse of the Year for Third Level out of 250 horses.

Aside from his stunning show record, San Rubin is a fine horse to work with and train. Without a doubt, there is not a horse that tries harder on the ranch than San Rubin. His children, thankfully, seem to have this same quality. Their excellent temperments and good work ethics make for a very easy horse to train and put under saddle.
