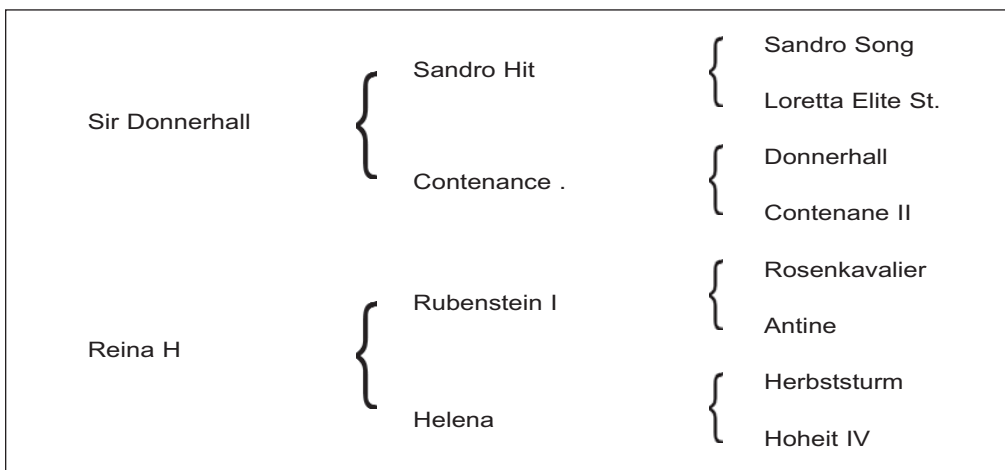

Origin: SIRRINGO is the first SIR DONNERHALL colt to be born in the United States, and also the first American-born colt by Sir Donnerhall to be licensed by the German Oldenburg Verband. His dam is the cornerstone mare REINA H (by Rubenstein I) of Yancey Farms in Florida. Sirringo's sire Sir Donnerhall, 2006 National Young Horse



National Champion and Reserve World Champion, has it all and has passed his royal pedigree onto Sirringo. Sir Donnerhall was distinguished at the Oldenburg Approvals in Vechta where he earned a 1c premium and at his 30 day test where he won in all three gaits with top scores between 9.0 and 10.0. The 'foreign' riders awarded him 9.5 for rideability. He was extremely impressive showing excellent rideability, rhythm, and suppleness. Sir Donnerhall was the 2005 Oldenburg County Champion in Rastede and won his 70 day test in Adelheidsdorf with a sensational result. He won the test and was awarded a dressage index of 163 points – a score never achieved by a stallion before. His jumping ability is also worth mentioning; he won this category as well with a total index of 151 points. Sir Donnerhall's sire, Sandro Hit, is proving to be an extremely successful stallion, both in dressage competition and as a sire of numerous top foals. In 1999 he became Six-Year-Old-Dressage-Horse-World-Champion, and winner at the German Federal Championships in Warendorf. As many as 10 licensed sons came out of his first foal crop. Sirringo has inherited the extraordinary and incredible movement and trainability of his sires and grandsires. Sirringo is here in the United States of America and through the prepotency of his world-renowned lineage, will pass on this extraordinary bloodline and superior athletic ability to his first foal crop.

Performance Record: Sirringo by Sir Donnerhall was carefully trained in both dressage and jumping to prepare for his stallion licensing/inspection in Solvang, California, in September of 2009. He gave a stunning performance and was licensed by the Oldenburg Verband and is able to start breeding immediately. At the age of two, Sirringo was the Grand Champion of the Shelly Siegel Memorial Show in California, with an invitation to the Great American USDF Breeder's Championships. He won all of his in-hand classes. Sirringo has schooled in dressage clinics with Jane Weatherwax and Axel Steiner, both of who commented on the drama and spectacular quality of his gaits, almost a perfect 9 or 10. Sirringo has the exaggerated gaits of his famous pedigree and is extremely athletic and uphill in his movement, his big gorgeous movement. He was inspected by the German licensing team of Katrin Berger and Uli Henschke. They loved his movement, his temperament, and his mind. In 2009, his performance training focused on the preparation for his successful stallion licensing; he will begin his dressage campaign in 2010 and is schooling 2nd level.
