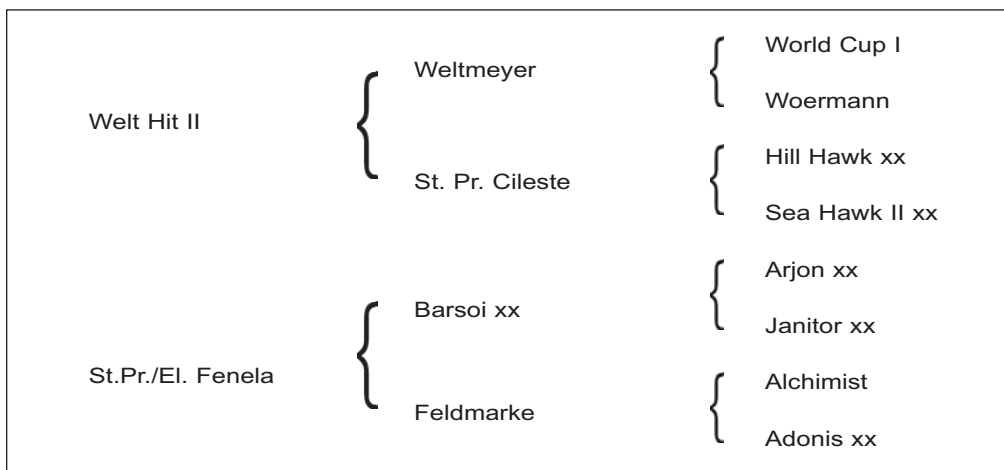

Origin: Weltissimo is sired by Welt Hit II, the most successful of the six Welt Hit stallions produced through the mating of Weltmeyer and St. Pr. Cileste.

Performance Record: Weltissimo won the dressage portion of his 100 Day Stallion Performance Test (Neustadt-Dosse, Germany) with the high score of 146.49. His rideability was scored at 9.50, character 10, walk and trot 9.33, and canter 9. At the Bundeschampionat (German National Championships) in 2001, Weltissimo was the Vice-Champion, and the next year as a six year old, he placed 3rd in top company. That same year at the World Young Horse Championships in Verden, he placed 4th in strong competition. The next year, he was the winner of the Auction Horse Youngster's Cup in Vechta with a score of 9.4. In 2004, Weltissimo was honored with the award of Dressage Stallion of the Year at the annual Oldenburg Stallion Days. Also in 2004, Weltissimo was awarded 7th place at the prestigious Nurnburger Burg-Pokal in Frankfurt. In addition to successes with Susan Draper Pape and Rudolph Zeilinger, Weltissimo has had many Grand Prix and Grand Prix Special victories and high placings with his current rider, Hubertus Schmidt in Germany and Austria in 2008.

Breeding/Progeny Record: Weltissimo has sired many outstanding foals of which there are more than two hundred in Germany/Europe. With five eighths Thoroughbred blood in his pedigree, he adds a refining element when bred to heavier warmblood mares. The quality of foals has been exceptional with regard to type, conformation, movement and temperament.
