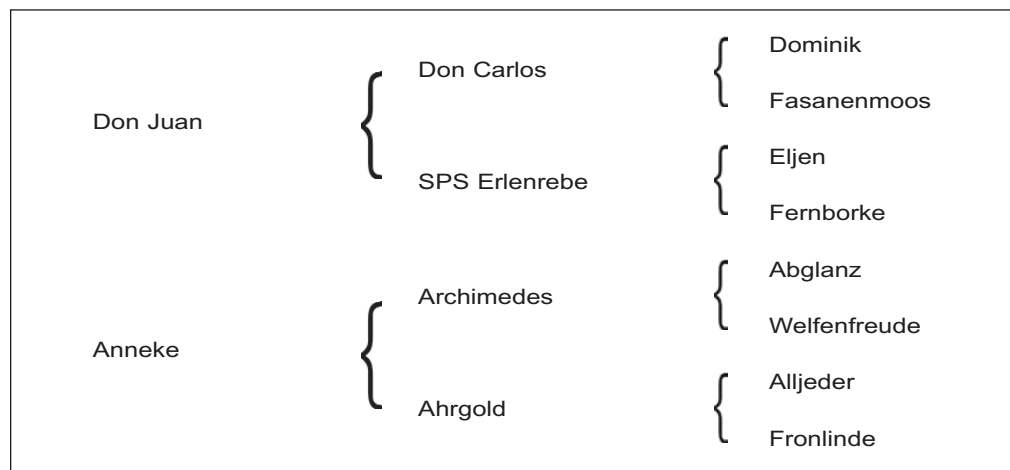

Origin: Don Alfredo is by Don Juan, who was Stallion of the Year in Germany in 1997 and has sired many successful international level performance horses. He is listed by the breeding value index as number 66 overall out of more than 1,000 stallions in his age group. Don Alfredo is out of Anneke by the State Stud-owned stallion Archimedes. Archimedes is a son of the Trakehner foundation sire Abglanz. Archimedes, born in 1963, has lifetime earnings of \$300,000 and is listed by the breeding value index as number 88 for dressage out of more than 1,500 stallions in his age group. Don Alfredo's 3/4 brother, Dulf, has been rated number 4 in the world in Grand Prix jumping and was an Olympic Silver Medal team member in the Sydney 2000 Olympics

Performance Record: Don Alfredo is a Class I stallion who completed the 11-month performance test at Adelheidsdorf with an overall score of 122.88 points. He finished 6th out of 36 stallions, earning scores that exceeded 120 points for both rideability and jumping.

Breeding/Progeny Record: Imported in 1996, Don Alfredo's oldest U.S. foals were born in '97, and have scored numerous in-hand wins at a variety of Breed Shows, with his first IHF Champion in 2000. Don Alfredo is siring numerous premium foals, Elite Mares and offspring showing successfully in the hunter and jumper rings. Don Alfredo is a beautiful stallion with elegant movement and an incredibly kind disposition that he definitely passes on to his offspring.
