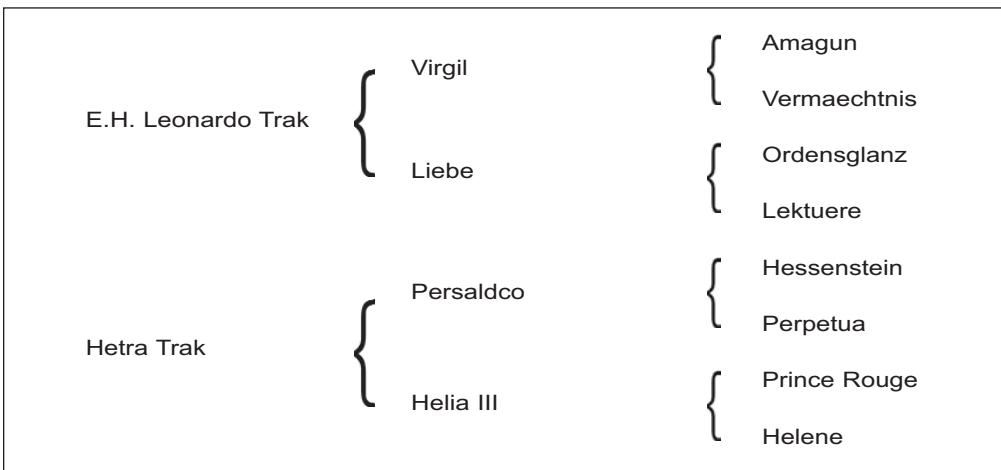

**Origin:** Herzberg, a most highly noble and elegant true-to-type Grand Prix Dressage Trakehner Stallion, has the infusion of Trak. Lightness and "blood" clearly sought after in the modern sporthorse. With some of the most successful and proven bloodlines, such as E.H Leonardo, a very worthy riding horse sire with extremely good active gaits. A sire who's progeny excelled at FEI Levels in Dressage and Jumping in Germany. Virgil, who was Champion at his Keuring in 1974 and Champion at his 100 day test in Medingen, Germany in 1975. Together with Herzberg's Dam Hetra, an elegant and Typey Trakehner mare with strong sporthorse features, comes such Legendary sires as Persaldo, Hessenstein and Ordensglanz.



**Performance Record:** After his Keuring, Herzberg went on to successfully pass his 100 day stallion testing at Adelheidsdorf, Germany. Herzberg then went on to Claim the Title Landeschampion of the 4 year olds in Jumping in South Germany with a score of 9.0!!! After that Herzberg was able to claim many ribbons in Material and young horse dressage and jumping classes in Germany. After his arrival to the United States, Herzberg has been very successful in Dressage Classes up to International CDI-W\*\*\* Level. In 2003 Herzberg has won numerous Prix St. George and Intermediaire I classe's with scores up to the 70's. Herzberg was Champion at the 2003 Pebble Beach CDI\*\*\* in the Intermediaire I Freestyle, and Reserve Campion in Prix St. George. At the CDI\*\*\* in Rancho Murrieta Herzberg was Reserve Champion PSG and 3rd at Inter. I. Herzberg was named 2003 ATA Prix St. George Horse of the Year, and 2003 Reserve Champion ATA Intermediaire I Horse of the Year. In 2004 Herzberg was ranked 13th by the USET Festival of Champions at Intermediaire I !! Herzberg finished the year with scores up to 73.750%. Including a clean winning sweep at the 2004 Pebble Beach CDI\*\*\* in the PSG, Inter.I, and Freestyle. Herzberg won the CDI\*\*\* Highpoint Perpetual Trophy. Herzberg also won the 2004 USDF HOY Intermediaire I ATA Award. In 2005 Herzberg was able to win his first Grand Prix class at the Festival of the Horse in Burbank, CA.!! At Rancho Murrieta CDI-W\*\*\* Herzberg was able to place 5th in the Grand Prix and 3rd in the Grand Prix Special also giving him his first world cup points. Herzberg ended up 14th in the USET Grand Prix Rankings in 2005 at his first year at Grand Prix.

**Breeding/Progeny Record:** 2005 was very exciting for Herzberg's offspring. A Colt out of a Figaro x Goldstern x Luciano mare became GOV Inspection Site Champion also capturing the Premium award. Another Colt by Herzberg out of a Pik's Pride x Ehrentusch Dam also captured the Premium Award. At another Inspection site Herzberg was also able to convince once more with another Premium colt out of a Rubicell Dam. Herzberg shows once again through his foals the Brilliance in movement with exceptional activity of the hindlimbs. All of Herzberg's foals stand out in beauty, presence and temperament! In 2004, 100% of Herzberg's foals received the Premium Award with multiple verbands. A GOV Premium colt is being raised as a stallion prospect out of a Rubicell (Rubinstein) Mare. Herzberg has sired many Elite State Premium Mares for the RPSI Verband in Germany, Herzberg is also consistent in throwing Gold Premium Champion Foals in Germany. In 2003 a Daughter of Herzberg was named Premium Mare in the USA by the RPSI verband, and a colt was imported from Germany to the USA.
