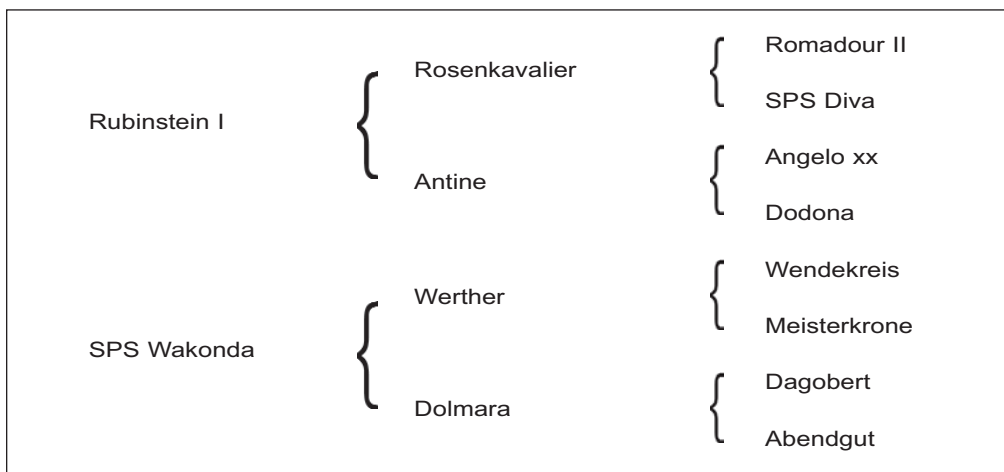

Origin: Regazzoni is by Rubinstein I out of the great Werther mare Wakonda. Regazzoni's legendary sire Rubinstein I has strongly influenced this era of sporthorse breeding and passes rideability, trainability and elegance. Regazzoni's damsire Werther is equally influential.

Performance Record: At his 100-day-test in 1994, Regazzoni scored an outstanding 140.53 points including perfect 10's for temperament and rideability, traits which he readily passes on to his offspring. His dressage index alone was 152.16 confirming him as the highest scoring stallion out of the 53 other stallions at the Munster-Handorf site. In 1995, Regazzoni was federal vice-champion German riding horse in Warendorf and in 1996, he won the finals of the German five-year old dressage championships.

Breeding/Progeny Record: Regazzoni has 13 approved sons, including North American stallions Ragtime, Regardez, and Ransom, and European stallions, Riccione, Riverside and Royal Highness. In performance tests, Regazzoni's sons have done well. The dressage scores of these sons were as follows: Regardez - 128.5 (3rd place overall), Ragtime - 130.2, Ransom - 134.9, Riverside - 138.5 (Champion of Testing), and Riccione - 144.89 (2nd place overall). Son, Riccione, was the record priced stallion of the 1998 Verden stallion market, selling for DM350.000. Son, Reingau, was the top selling colt of the unlicensed stallions at the Verden stallion licensing in 1998. Regazzoni has also sired top selling auction horses, including Revue Girl PSI and Rittmeister PSI. Regazzoni's daughters are also very accomplished. Ragtime Princess represented Belgium in the Young Horse Championships in Germany. Ribera Grande was the best Hanoverian mare at the 2000 Euro-Mare Championships in Brussels, Belgium. St. Pr. Ravenna M was highly placed at the 2000 Federal Championship in Warendorf. In the qualification finals of the 2005 Bundeschampionate, Royal Highness placed 1st with a score of 9.3 out of 43 horses. The stallion, Riverside, placed 26th with a score of 7.5. In the finals, Royal Highness went on to tie for 4th place with a score of 8.7. After scoring 9th (Royal Highness) and 14th (Riverside) in the qualifying round of the 2005 World Championships for Young Dressage Horses 5-year old division, these two Regazzoni sons went on to place well against tough competition in the finals. Riverside was placed 7th in the consolation finals, and Royal Highness placed 6th in the finals.
