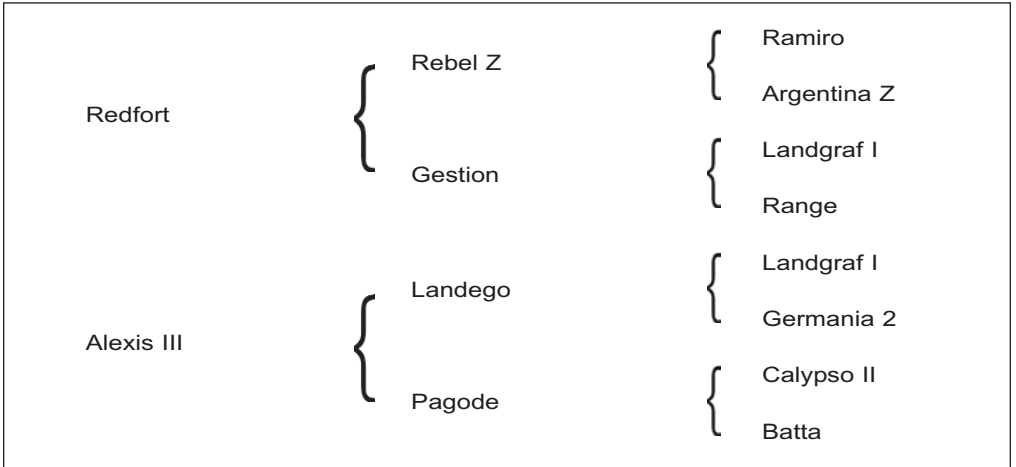

Origin: Riverman's pedigree offers access to many of the top bloodlines successful in international sport. His sire Redfort is by Rebel Z, the full brother to Ratina Z, the 1992 Silver medalist in Show Jumping and the highest ranked mare in the WBFSH International Breeders Guide for 1999/2000. The influence of Alme (sire of Argentina Z, the dam of Rebel Z) adds an interesting dimension to Riverman's pedigree. Riverman bears the world proven influence of Landego, Calypso II, Landgraf I, and Cor de la Bryere.

Performance Record: Riverman stood out early as the Top Model and Reserve Champion of his Holsteiner stallion licensing. Upon his importation to the US, Riverman won the 1995 Grand Championship at Dressage at Devon. Riverman was trained through Grand Prix prior to his retirement.

Breeding/Progeny Record: Riverman earned his place in the German FN's 2000 statistics as one of the top sires of his generation. Riverman stood 2nd in the FN's Jumping Index and 3rd in the Overall Index for stallions of his age group, due to the success of his offspring in both dressage and jumping competition. Approved sons Reno, Royal Appearance, and Rhett Butler have all been actively campaigned on the show jumping circuit and Reno made a successful move up to Grand Prix competition in 2006.

In the dressage arena, Riviera and River Boy were 10th and 15th respectively in the USDF Horse of the Year standings for Fourth Level, and River Run Roscoe is competing at the FEI level in CDIs. Another approved son, Rivano, is a consistent winner on the A-level hunter circuit displaying his sire's lovely jump and light movement.

Numerous offspring of Riverman's, including R Star, Roanoke, and Rohobeth, are successful Preliminary level and above eventers. Their speed, boldness, scope, and beautiful movement create an almost unbeatable package. Natasha Grigg's grey pair of Rivermans are applying those same skills to combined driving at the FEI Advanced Level with Larry Poulin to represent the US internationally this season.
