Performance Record: Rodioso made his in-hand debut in 2001 and was named Champion Stallion and IBC winner at the Potomac Valley Dressage Association's August show. He followed that success with the Stallion Championship and Mature Horse Championship at the New England Dressage Association's CDI Breed Show. He finished his first show season by being named Grand Champion Stallion and Oldenburg IBC Winner at the prestigious Devon Horse Show in Pennsylvania. The following two years he was shown under saddle in dressage thru third level by his importer Dr. Jan Williams. He received numerous year-end awards from the USDF in their Horse of the Year program. In the summer of 2004 Rodioso was acquired by Rodioso Ventures LLC and moved to the Seattle, Washington area. In 2005 his show career continued at 4th level with great success under Pamela Pentz placing 3rd with Oldenburgs in the USDF Horse of the Year at 4th level. His in-hand career also continued with even greater success. He placed 1st in Oldenburg Stallions in the USDF All Breeds Horse of the Year and placed 4th over all in the Open Horse of the Year for Sporthorse Breeding. He was named Grand Champion Stallion for the Pacific Northwest Series for the Cosequin/USDF in-hand finals.

Rodioso began his FEI career in 2006 at Prix St. Georges. He achieved scores up to 71% and placed at the USDF Region 6 Finals at PSG. He was also awarded 5th place nationally by the USEF Silver Stirrup Awards program. Rodioso is currently showing in 2007 at the Intermediate I level with scores consistently in the 60's. His offspring are now also beginning to show in the dressage arena and doing very well.

Rodioso began his FEI career in 2006 at Prix St. Georges. He achieved scores up to 71% and placed at the USDF Region 6 Finals at PSG. He was also awarded 5th place nationally by the USEF Silver Stirrup Awards program. Rodioso is currently showing in 2007 at the Intermediate I level with scores consistently in the 60's. His offspring are now also beginning to show in the dressage arena and doing very well.

Breeding/Progeny Record: Rodioso's first foal crop arrived in North America in 2002. They have had a very high percentage of premium awards and their most outstanding feature is their lovely necks, shoulders and temperaments. The youngsters coming under saddle are showing excellent trainability. Rebecca is a 2003 Premium filly who won Junior Rider High Point with a 69.9% first time out at Training Level May 2007. Ruffiano is out of the main mare book mare Lieselotte (Bavarian). He earned a 9th place in the USDF Horse of the Year 2005 colts, placed 2nd in the All Breeds USDF for Oldenburg, 1st in the New England Region 8 Finals and Reserve Champion in the NEDA Futurity. In 2006 he continued his winning ways by placing 5th in the NEDA yearling colt Futurity. Rochambeau is a 2002 Half-Arab gelding who is doing very well in dressage. At his first outing at the Pacific Coast Arabian Sporthorse Classic he placed first in his training level class with a 67%. Many of Rodioso's foals have numerous wins on the line. Reno a 2006 colt who placed first in colts of 2006 with an 81% at the Beaujolais Sporthorse Show when he was only two months old. Rane is a premium filly of 2005 who placed 2nd in fillies of 2005 at the Beaujolais Sport Horse Show with a score of 80.9%.
