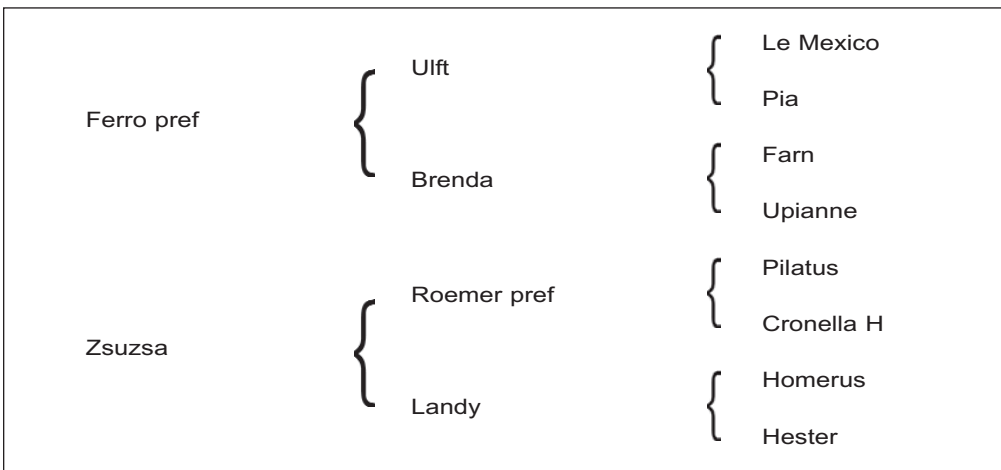

Performance Record: Rousseau was in the Championship Ring of the 2001 KWPN Stallion Show. He was then the top selling stallion/horse of the 2001 KWPN Select Sale. He earned an overall 8.5 for dressage at his stallion performance testing in Ermelo. Rousseau went on to win the PAVO Cup (the Dutch National Championships) as a four year old and won the KWPN Stallion Show as a 5-year old. Rousseau's international debut was an absolute success, when he won the Silver Medal of the FEI World Championships for Young Horses in 2003.

Rousseau stood as an active breeding stallion in the Netherlands for three years, covering over 1000 mares, before moving to Germany to breed for the Hanoverian, Oldenburg, and Westphalian breeding districts.

Breeding/Progeny Record: He bears the highest dressage index of all Dutch stallions, as indicated by the 2007 KWPN Stallion index (181 points), due to the success and quality of his offspring undersaddle. He has twice produced the Champion of the KWPN Stallion Show: 2006 Wamberto (Rousseau-Voltaire) and 2007 Blue Hors Zack (Rousseau-Jazz), who was sold to Blue Hors Stud as the highest-selling horse ever sold through the KWPN Select Sale for 430,000 Euro's. 2002: Several foals selected for elite foal auctions; excellent foal report. 2004: Rousseau colts #2 and #3 at Dutch National Foal Championships held at KWPN Paardendagen. 2005 son V.I.P. (Rousseau-Farrington-Amor) licensed at 2005 KWPN Stallion Show; Overall Champion Ster mare of North Holland Violita (Rousseau-Krack C) also placed 3rd at National Mare Show at KWPN Paardendagen; Ajong (Rousseau-Flemmingh) topped Borculo Elite Foal Auction (41,000). Rousseau offspring take top four titles Champion and Reserve Champion Fillies and Colts at Hengststation Pape Foal Show in Germany. 2006 Eleven sons selected for KWPN Stallion Show, five licensed including Champion Stallion Wamberto (Rousseau-Voltaire-Dutchboy). Wodora (Rousseau-Columbus) placed 4th at KWPN National Mare Show in Three Year Ster Mare dressage class. Offspring Results in North America: 2003: #6 foal Wrigley on NA/WPN's Top Ten; 2004: #3 foal Zsunami on NA/WPN's Top Ten; Ravena is Site Champion Hanoverian foal; 2005: Rousseau sired four foals in the NA/WPN 2005 Top Ten, ranking #1, Arturo, #5 Ad Lib Se, #7 Arousseau, and #8 Armani. Armani wins Colts of 2005 class at Dressage At Devon with 89.4%. Ravena wins Champion Yearling Filly at Fair Hill Sporthorse Breed Show with 84.1%. 2006: Roquelle is Site Champion Hanoverian foal; Armani places 2nd in Yearling Colts class at DAD and 6th in KWPN-NA Two Years and Under class; Zanita places 3rd in KWPN-NA Two Years and Under class at DAD. Winnetou wins DG Bar Cup qualifier at ISF and places 3rd overall; Wiando places 2nd on KWPN-NA 2006 Top Ten in 3-year old geldings movement division. Bacara SVS places 5th on KWPN-NA 2006 Top Ten foals list. 2007: KWPN-NA Top Five Results - Bekka CF #2 Yearlings; Zonnerhall #3 DG Bar Cup-3 Year Olds; Wrigley #4 Dressage Gelding/Stallions; Armani #5 Two Year Olds, Zandreau JP #5 DG Bar Cup-3 Year Olds.
