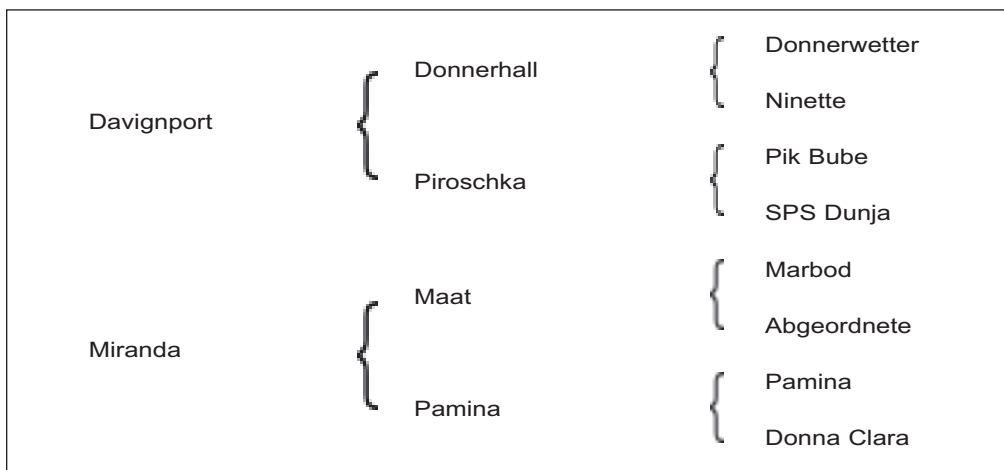

Performance Record: Davignport enjoyed a successful seasons at Prix St. Georges and Intermediaire in fact he won every Intermediaire entered. USDF ranked Davignport 4th out of 127 stallions based on the success of his offspring in dressage. This ranking also included European stallions producing dressage horses in the U.S. We were especially pleased because his oldest crop are only 5 years old ! This ranking was based on the success of his offspring with USDF

Breeding/Progeny Record: One of his stars was Dew Berry winner of the A.H.S. Hartwig Trophy, given to the highest scoring Mare Performance test .She earned a perfect 10 in free jumping. Other highlights from the USDF/Cosequin Breeders Championship series were : Dieter - Champion Southern Series and AHS Champion young horse colt/geld. . Davida , Res. Ch. Mid South Series, D Bocelli, Res. Ch. East Coast Series and Donegal, 4TH East Coast Series. At Dressage at Devon in 2003 all of the Davignport offspring earned ribbons with the highlight being Doodle Dandy a 03 colt owned by Ginny Friedhoff. He won his weanling class, was Champion colt and Reserve Champion Young horse. He made it all the way to the Grand Champion ring! Not bad for a foal!

We continue to get reports of superior rideability and of how easy his offspring are to break. They show talent not only as Dressage horses but Hunters as well. Two fine examples are Demi aka Velvet out of a TB dam bred by Mike and Jean Bitley and Davidoff out of St. Pr. Carballina by Calypso II .
