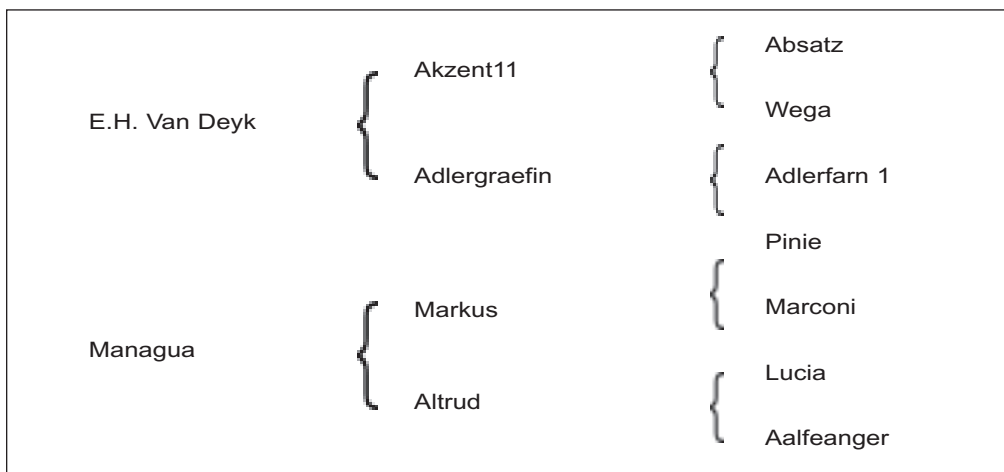

**Origin:** Sire, E.H. Van Deyk was a very successful Grand Prix Dressage horse in Germany, who is the son of a TB (Patricius xx) out of the great mare Vanessa by Ibikus. He was granted "Elite" status by the German Trakehner Verband, based on his performance and the performance of his offspring (including several approved sons).

Dam, Managua, is from the mare family of Flamme which has a record for producing show jumpers just as well as dressage horses and the list of approved stallions out of that line could not be more interesting: Falkensee, Falkner, Flugwind, Fliedergeist, Avec Plaisir the the two champions Freudenfest and Farinelli. To top it all, the third dam Flocke is also dam of the tremendously important sire Flaneur.

**Performance Record:** Kuering 1994 Trakehner Verband, and successful 100 day test.

**Breeding/Progeny Record:** Feingeist was approved for the Trakehner Verband in Germany in 1994 winning the prize for best Trakehner type at his approval. He was subsequently approved for Oldenburg Breeding in 2004, after being imported to Canada. His bloodline brings to the North American market a very interesting infusion of thoroughbred blood that is so important in producing modern performance horses. Feingeist is a tall, "leggy" individual, with fantastic athletic ability for jumping and excellent movement for dressage. He has produced Premium studbook mares in the German Trakehner Verband, with offspring performing in both jumping and dressage. His first foal crop in Canada were all granted premium status by the Oldenburg Verband.
