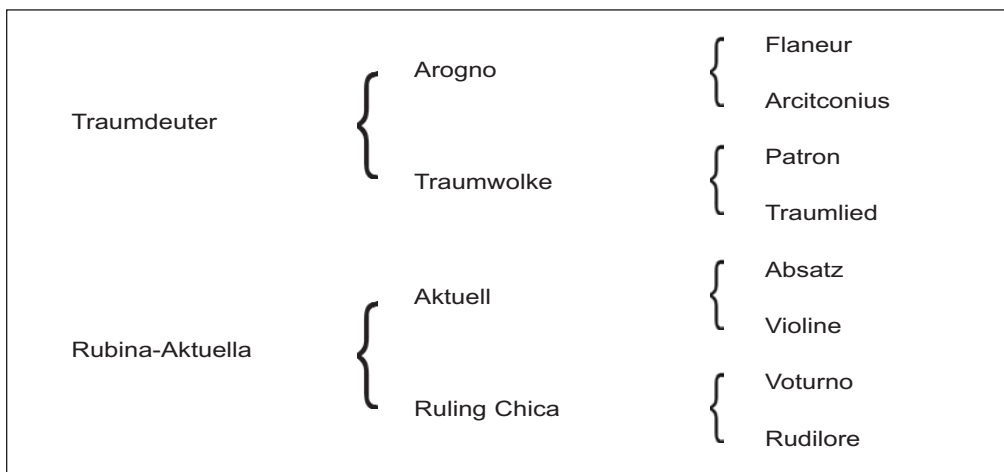

Performance Record: Tantris is a proven Grand Prix dressage competitor and a potent, versatile sire from one of the most important mare lines in Germany today. He refines the heavier mares, while adding bone and elasticity to Thoroughbreds. He consistently passes along his remarkable temperament and character, balanced uphill toplines, powerful hindquarters and great feet! His athletic, offspring have been successful in dressage, hunters and combined driving with over 90% re breeding!



Tantris sire, Traumdeuter, a Trakehner, is also approved as a Hanoverian and Oldenburg breeding stallion. His dam's sire, Aktuell, is a St. Pr. H. (state premium stallion) in the Hanoverian and Oldenburg German studbooks. The great event horse, Volturno, who won the silver medal in the 1976 Olympics, is his grandsire on the Dam's side. In addition to a busy breeding schedule each year, he has consistently won many National Championships from Training level in 1993 through Grand Prix in 2004 (Tantris won both the BLM and USDF all breeds Championships at Intermediaire II for 2003 and was Res. Champion for Grand Prix at GAIG in 2004) as well as many Breed Show Championships.

Breeding/Progeny Record: Tantris is a prepotent sire, and incredibly fertile. His many premium foals have matured into successful sport horses in multiple disciplines, such as his daughters Tahiti, Tradewind, Tekla, Tarantella, and his sons Tyberius, Traumweber (Farmer's Row), Tango, Tamborin, Triumph, Tristan and Traum. All of them top-scoring horses in Dressage, winning at the BLM and Regional Championships as well as USDF Horse of the Year All Breeds Awards. In addition, Traumweber, Catch a Dream and Tango have also excelled in the Hunter and Equitation arenas for their new owners. Triumph and Traum are fulfilling their famous heritage in the world of Eventing. Tradewind has had super results in the Jumper ring and Warwick is the lead horse in a combined driving team in Michigan.
