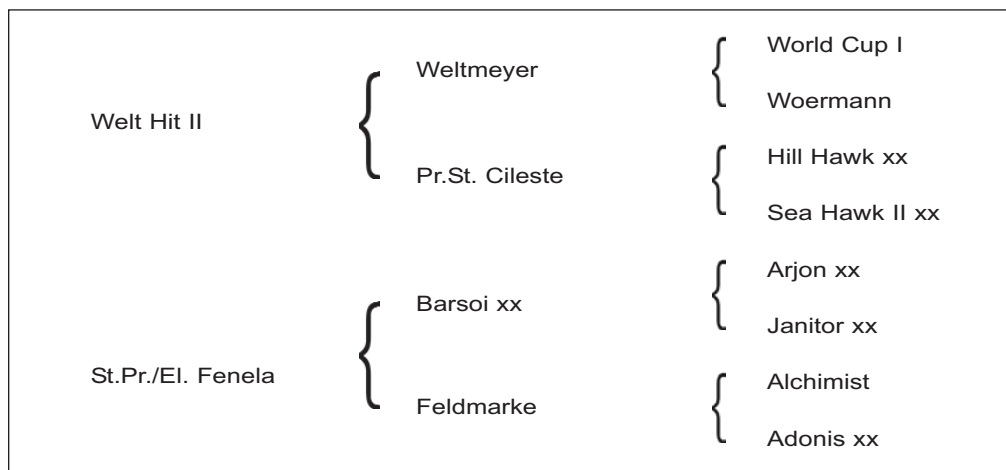

Origin/Performance Record: Weltissimo is sired by Welt Hit II, the most successful of the six Welt Hit stallions produced through the mating of Weltmeyer and Cileste. Weltissimo won the dressage portion of his 100 Day Stallion Performance Test with the high score of 146.49. His rideability was scored at 9.50, character 10, walk and trot 9.33 and canter 9. At the Bundeschampionat (German National Championships) in 2001, Weltissimo was the Vice-Champion, and the next year as a six year old, he placed 3rd. That same year at the World Young Horse Championships in Verden, he placed 4th in strong competition. The next year, he was the winner of the Auction Horse Youngster's Cup with a score of 9.4. In 2004, Weltissimo was honored with the award of Dressage Stallion of the Year at the annual Oldenburg Stallion Days. Also in 2004, Weltissimo was awarded 7th place at the prestigious Nurnburger Burg-Pokal in Frankfurt. He has many victories and high placings at numerous shows through Grand Prix with his regular rider, Susan Draper Pape, and trainers Ingo Pape and Rudolph Zeilinger. As a nine year old at his first Grand Prix in 2005, Weltissimo placed 7th, ridden by Rudolph Zeilinger, who has trained Weltissimo during the off-breeding season for the past three years. Weltissimo has sired outstanding foals, the oldest of which have started their sport careers in 2006.

Breeding/Progeny Record: There are over two hundred Weltissimo offspring in Germany from many different mare lines and types. The quality has been exceptional.
